#### What is E-Rate?

E-Rate (also known as the Schools and Library Program of the Universal Service Fund) is a life-saver and budget extender for many schools trying to keep up with telecom and internet technology.

Eligible participants include public and most non-profit K-12 schools as well as all public and many private libraries. Program participants must carry out a competitive bidding process to select the most single line vs. across two lines companies to

requested. Program participants may request funding in five categories of service: Telecommunications, Telecommunications Services, Internet Access, Internal Connections, and Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections. Discounts for support depend on the level of poverty and the urban/rural status of the population served.
